## Construction Guidelines

- Measurements:** **Maximum Height: 6'0"** **Maximum Width: 6'0"** **Maximum Depth: 6'0"**  
Please account for the roof, overhangs, eaves of porch, chimneys or other decorative items. If any measurement exceeds the maximum, the house cannot be accepted for display.
- Materials:** Dog houses should be built for outdoor use if possible, using materials that are safe for dogs. Dog houses will be moved into Penn Square Mall by manpower. Please do all you can to keep the houses as lightweight as possible while maintaining a quality appearance. This is equally important once the owners take the houses to their homes, as most yards are not accessible to trucks or forklifts.
- Roofing:** Please try to use roofing materials that will withstand outdoor elements.
- Exposed Dangers:** Please pay special attention to exposed corners, sharp edges and unfinished materials. Also, please fasten any decorative items securely.
- Signage:** We will provide all signage for each entry. Please do not attach your own. There should be no company advertisements on the dog house itself.
- Maintenance:** Your dog house will be on display for one week and may experience some wear and tear from the thousands of people getting a closer look. Any paint touch ups are your responsibility during the event.
- Transportation:** The dog houses should be delivered to Penn Square Mall on Sunday March 14 between 7am and 10am. Dog houses will be moved into place by manpower.
