Responsibilities:

Committee members help to identify and inform groups of potential applicants about the Habitat program. Many people who may need and want our program do not know what Habitat is or what it does, and many misconceptions abound. Detailed training enables members of this committee to go into the community and educate individuals, businesses, foundations, churches, and civic groups about the resource Habitat represents for lower income families to achieve home ownership. Often, footwork is needed just to get information to specific places on a routine basis. Recruitment Committee members brainstorm together to come up with potential contacts and then divide up to individually connect with those contacts and work with them.
