With 36 years under our tool belt, and with more than 1,120 houses built to date, Central Oklahoma Habitat has become a major homebuilder in Oklahoma City, constructing about 35 houses a year. Our work in land development and homebuilding puts us in the top 10 of Habitat for Humanity International's 1,400 affiliates.

Infill lots

Central Oklahoma Habitat has built more than 690 homes on lots all over the metro area. Existing lots in older, already developed parts of town are known as "infill" lots and 63% of our homes are built on this kind of real estate. Because of economic conditions, infill lots are becoming harder to find and more expensive. Locations include Metro Park, Shidler-Wheeler, Classen 10 Penn, etc.
